- 4. One additional sheet may be added to help with completion of questions.
- 5. Open to High School Seniors, Freshmen and Sophomores in post-secondary education, including college, university or technical school.
- 6. Must be a full time student.
- 7. **POSTMARKED BY MARCH 1** to the UW-Extension Office, 1926 Hall Avenue, Marinette WI 54143 and to the attention of the 4-H office.
- 8. Possible interview if needed to help make a decision.
- 9. Up to five scholarships, in an amount of \$750 each will be awarded yearly to deserving youths. (Not necessarily given every year).
- 10. Awarded on merit and 4-H involvement, not financial needs.
- 11. Scholarship committee will select recipients names will be presented to the 4-H Association Board for approval.
- 12. Scholarship money is budgeted by the Leaders Association each year.
- 13. Money will be awarded to recipient after proof of completion of first semester and intent to continue education.
- 14. Scholarship can be received only once. If not granted a scholarship, you may apply again up to a Sophomore in college.
- 15. Sell yourself!! The Scholarship Committee <u>cannot</u> give you credit for something unless it is written down (even if they know you did it).
- 16. Please write an acceptance/thank you letter.
