

CRITERIA AND GUIDELINES FOR MARINETTE COUNTY 4-H LEADERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS (Established September 1995)

1. Complete an application form (typed or neatly printed) - Two (2) recommendation letters (should be typed). Not accepted if late, unsigned or incomplete.
2. Must have been in 4-H at least four (4) years.
3. Must be a 4-H graduate of Marinette County or eligible to graduate.
4. One additional sheet may be added to help with completion of questions.
5. Open to High School Seniors, Freshmen and Sophomores in post-secondary education, including college, university or technical school.
6. Must be a full time student.
7. **POSTMARKED BY MARCH 1** to the UW-Extension Office, 1926 Hall Avenue, Marinette WI 54143 and to the attention of the 4-H office.
8. Possible interview if needed to help make a decision.
9. Up to five scholarships, in an amount of \$750 each will be awarded yearly to deserving youths. (Not necessarily given every year).
10. Awarded on merit and 4-H involvement, not financial needs.
11. Scholarship committee will select recipients - names will be presented to the 4-H Association Board for approval.
12. Scholarship money is budgeted by the Leaders Association each year.
13. Money will be awarded to recipient after proof of completion of first semester and intent to continue education.
14. Scholarship can be received only once. If not granted a scholarship, you may apply again up to a Sophomore in college.
15. Sell yourself!! The Scholarship Committee cannot give you credit for something unless it is written down (even if they know you did it).
16. Please write an acceptance/thank you letter.
