- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Avoid crowding - minimum floor space in hutches 7, 10, 15 square feet for small, medium and large breeds respectively.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Clean water vessels and hutch floors weekly.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Construct hutch floor of 1/2" x 1/2" or 1/2" x 1" welded wire or slats for cleanliness.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Remove all manure and dirt from rabbitry each week.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Use self-feeders for does with litters (depends on the breed).
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Feed a well balanced rabbit ration.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Test-mate each doe five days after first mating to avoid misses.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. Keep record accurately - i.e. Hutch Card.
