2. Participate in an interview (watch 4-H newsletter for date). Interviews are held in October and February.
3. Receive notification stating which trips you were chosen to receive sponsorship for. Awards remain a surprise and are given out at annual county achievement day.

Citizenship Washington Focus (CWF), Washington D.C.	(Summer, 2022)	10th-12th grade
1-2 youth per county. Week includes workshops, speakers, committee work, field trips and social events.		
National 4-H Congress, Atlanta, Georgia	(Nov. 26-30, 2021)	10th-12th grade
Trip offers an opportunity to meet with 4-H members from across the nation. Self development, leadership and community service will be key in this five-day trip.		
National 4-H Conference, Washington D.C.	(2022. Date TBA)	10th-12th grade
6-8 youth from Wisconsin are selected to attend this working civic engagement conference. One day is spent at Capitol Hill meeting with legislators and touring.		
Space Camp, Huntsville, Alabama	(2021 cancelled)	6th-8th grade
An experience of a lifetime! This five-day trip offers hands-on opportunities including simulated shuttle missions, experiments in the space station, launching & landing spacecraft and more. Maximum age of 15 at time of trip. Space Camp counselors may be in Grade 7-10.		
Advanced Space Camp, Huntsville, Alabama	(?)	10th-12th grade
An in-depth science experience including a six hour simulated space shuttle/space station mission, pilot simulators and micro-gravity environments. Tour of U.S. Space and Rocket Center. Limited enrollment.		
American Spirit Experience, East Coast	(2021 cancelled)	8th-10th grade
Youth from neighboring counties participate in a nine-day bus tour where they are immersed into Americas's history in the eastern states. Limited enrollment.		
Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference, WI	(Aug. 17, 2021)	7th-10th grade
Approximately 600 youth attended this event each summer. Take part in educational seminars in everything from kayaking to the performing arts and everything in between.		
National 4-H Dairy Conference, Madison WI	(Oct. 2, 2022)	10th-12th grade
Join 200 youth from 4-H dairy projects in U.S. & Canada. Learn about production, processing, marketing and careers including biotechnology and genetics. Includes speakers, tours and visiting the World Dairy Expo. Must have 3+ years in 4-H dairy project & outstanding dairy accomplishment records.		
Winter Leadership Camp, Wisconsin	(February, 2022)	6th-8th grade
Improve your leadership skills through hands-on activities and opportunities to participate in a variety of outdoor recreational activities.		
Wisconsin 4-H Key Award	(Nominations due to Extension office by Sept. 1)	9th-13th grade
Recognizes select 4-H members who have demonstrated consistent growth, developed and applied leadership skills and actively participated in their 4-H club and community. Must have 3 years of 4-H and 1 year youth leadership.		
Golden Clover Award (County Award)		8th-12th grade
Recognizes a 4-H member who has been an active leader in the club and at the county level.		
Fall Forum, Green Lake, WI	(November 6, 2021)	7th-13th grade & adults
Many interactive workshops & a celebration to induct WI 4-H Hall of Fame nominees.
