Badger Park

Peshtigo 715-582-4321

3,000 ft. of park along the Peshtigo River. The Park can be divided into four areas including (the trail system, wooded area, disc golf), the northern picnicking playground, Badger Campground, and the Badger Swimming/Volleyball area

Dave's Falls Park \$

County Park Road, Amberg 715-732-7530

Explore by climbing rocks, multiple walking paths along the river and many trails that weave you around Dave's Falls. There is an upper and lower falls area that is connected by a wooden bridge. This Park has pit toilets, a picnic area and playground.

Dolan Lake Park \$

Dolan Lake Road, Athelstane
This is a small park located on serene Dolan Lake
that is used for non-motorized sports. It has
wonderful fishing for Pan fish, Largemouth Bass
and Northern Pike. Launch your kayak, wade in the
water, have a picnic or cast a line while you are
here. There are pit toilets available.

Long Slide Park \$

Hwy 141, E on Morgan Park Road, Niagara Long Slide Falls is a magnificent spot. Take the pathway East to the bottom of the falls or choose to follow the sounds of the roaring thunder and view the Falls from the top. The trail from the bottom back up is definitely a hike so bring your walking shoes! *Bonus Waterfall Nearby to Google*: Smalley Falls

Goodman Park \$

N15201 Goodman Park Road, Athelstane 715-732-7530

This Park has a lot of exploring opportunities alongside the Peshtigo River. Cross over the wooden bridge to view "Strong Falls" flowage. There are pit toilets, a playground, 15 rustic campsites, 2 lodges and a cabin for rental and hiking opportunities. This Park has a mapped walking trail that connects to McClintock Park, which is home to McClintock Rapids, and another County Park that is a definite must see.

Harmony Arboretum

N3890 County E, Peshtigo 460-acre county park with hardwood forest, winding walking trails, a restored prairie, and demonstration gardens including a children's garden, hobby greenhouse, fruit orchard, and bird

Lake Noquebay Park \$

A large open concept park with a playground, beach with change house and flush toilets for swimmers, grill, vault toilets, pavilion, boat landing and a lodge available for rental. Bring your boat to launch and fishing pole.

Menominee River Park \$

N9012 Park Place Drive, Wausaukee This Park provides a beautiful view of the Menominee River, a picnic area that includes a small open-sided shelter pavilion, fishing, vault toilets, horseshoe pits, and a boat landing.

McClintock Park \$

W14218 County Road I, Athelstane 715-732-7530

This Park has 320 acres of hiking and wandering! The largest in Marinette County. There are four wooden bridges built overflowing rapids, many peninsulas, and boulders to relax on. This Park has a mapped walking trail that connects to Goodman Park, which is home to Strong Falls. 1/2-mile South are 10 rustic ATV campsites at McClintock Campground.

Michaelis Park

Shore Drive, Marinette A quaint park with a picnic table, swimming access, and views of Lake Michigan.

Morgan Park \$

Nestled on Timms Lake, this park is for day use equipped with a beach, shower house, picnic area, playground, a developed and marked hiking trail and 45 electric campsites. Use the no wake lake for fishing, kayaks, canoes, or paddleboats!

Twelve Foot Falls Park \$

12 Foot Falls Road, Dunbar 715-732-7530

Picnic here with the family and explore not just one, but two waterfalls in one park! Twelve Foot falls is visible right from the parking lot, and eight-foot falls is found down a trail marked through the woods. There is plenty to explore, so please hike around and consider staying in one of the 12 rustic campsites. *Bonus Waterfalls Nearby to Google:* 18 Foot, Carney Rapids and 4 Foot Falls

Twin Bridge Park \$

N9714 Parkway Road, Crivitz 715-732-7530

This Park is located on High Falls Flowage on the Peshtigo River. It has two sandy swimming beaches, with one that allows your dog(s) to cool off with you. Next to the beach area is a large picnic area with grills and picnic tables to use along with a large playground. Visit the rock outcrop overlooking the water. Before you leave, take a stroll through the 62-site electric campground and consider a future stay.

Veterans Memorial Park \$

Parkway Road, Stephenson 715-732-7530

This Park has 15 electric campsites, a large picnic area next to a playground and beautiful views of the Thunder River. Take the wood and stone steps at the rear of the picnic area to the Thunder River to see Veteran's Falls. There is an alternate path to the falls behind the men's pit toilet for a smoother accessible path. Follow the trail that leads to the wooden bridge overlooking the falls for the best views.
